- R 1. **Harrington & Richardson Model M48 Topper.** Serial # H47989. 12 Ga. single shot shotgun with a 30" barrel. The bore will clean to very good/excellent. The barrel is choked Full. The blued metal finish on the barrel has been re-blued and again shows heavy surface rust. The receiver is worn to a bare gray with light surface rust. The trigger guard and opening lever have been re-blued and show plum hue. The plain walnut forearm is in good condition with marks from use and finish wear. The butt stock is in fair to good condition with marks from use with finish wear. There is a crack through the pistol grip. Aluminum Remington butt plate. Action works OK. Manufactured 1943 to 1956. C&R.
2. **Unknown Maker Model Percussion Shotgun.** Serial # NSN. Approx. 16 Ga/.65 caliber (0.650") single barrel percussion fired shotgun with a 42" part round/part octagon barrel. The bore is lightly rusted. The bore is smooth, but it is equipped with fixed rifle sights, presumably to fire single projectiles. The lock plate is un-marked. The only marking on the barrel is a Belgian E/LG proof. The metal finish on the barrel is a brown patina with surface rust and a few small dings. The lock plate is a brown patina with some pitting. Brass butt plate, trigger guard and ferrules. The full length walnut stock is checkered at the wrist with numerous small dings and a large repair at the heel of the butt. Action does not function correctly. Includes a wood ramrod.
3. **Unknown Maker Model Hammer Double Barrel.** Serial # NSN. Approx. 12 Ga. black powder percussion fired double barrel hammer shotgun with 30" Damascus barrels. The bores are fair with light rust. Belgian proofed on the underside of the barrels. Barrel rib is marked "Real Twist". The engraved side plates are not marked. Double triggers. The finish on the metal is a cleaned gray patina with some twist pattern visible on the barrels. Engraved steel butt plate, trigger guard and ferrules have all been cleaned. The checkered walnut half stock is in good condition with dings scratches. Extra finish has been applied with some paper stuck to it on the butt. The action works, it is sluggish and the right hammer will not hold on half-cock. Includes the ramrod.
- R. 4. **Spandau Model GEW 98.** Serial # 9511. 8mm Mauser caliber bolt action rifle with a 29-1/2" barrel. The bore is very good to excellent, clean with strong rifling. The receiver is dated 1915. Appears to be mostly matching with only the mid-band mis-matched. Lange rear sight. The blued metal finish on the barrel and receiver looks like it was re-finished years ago. It looks like the metal was buffed. The markings are intact, but washed out. There is also some scattered dots of light freckling and the finish is starting to turn brown. The bolt has been polished bright. There is a rod attachment clipped to the chamber area marked "WH Co"; it is part of a mud cover used in the trenches of WWI to keep mud out of the action. It is installed backwards and is missing the actual bolt cover. The plain walnut stock and handguard are in good condition with some minor marks from use. Extra finish gas been added. The action works fine. Rifle appears to be complete except for the rear sling attachment.

- R. 5. **U.S. Springfield Armory Model 1898 Krag.** Serial # 172693. .30-40 Krag caliber bolt action rifle with a 30" barrel. The bore is fair, dark and slightly rough with good rifling. It may clean better. Made in 1899. The blued metal finish on the barrel is heavily worn with older cleaned surface rust. The receiver is worn to a bare gray shows some thinning and scratching. The plain walnut stock is in fair condition, it is very dark with numerous dents and dings and a small crack at the upper tang. The handguard is in poor condition with numerous cracks and repairs. Stock cartouche is not visible. 1902 type rear sight. The action works, but is sluggish with a weak mainspring. Includes a newer leather sling and a bayonet. C&R.
- R. 6. **Japanese Model Type 38 Sporter.** Serial # 44857. 6.5x50 caliber bolt action rifle with a 23" barrel. The bore is fair, dirty and rough, it may clean better. The rifle has been sporterized. The original military barrel has been cut down and the sights removed. Military bolt is mis-matched and has not been altered. The blued metal finish is in very good condition showing light wear with a bare patch on the barrel where the rear sight was and where the mum was ground on the receiver. The checkered walnut Bishop sporter stock is in good condition with some marks from use and extra finish added. Magazine floor plate and follower are missing. The action seems to work OK. Caliber should be checked prior to firing. C&R.
7. **Investarm Model Hawken Flintlock Rifle Left Hand.** Serial # A602751. .50 caliber black powder LEFT HAND flintlock rifle with a 29" octagon barrel. The bore is very good with strong rifling, no rust visible. Made in Italy. Working double set triggers. The original blued metal finish on the barrel is in excellent condition with only a few minor marks. The lock plate and hammer show good case color. The plain hardwood stock is in excellent condition showing no wear. The brass trigger guard, butt plate, patch box, and forearm tip are in very good to excellent condition and will polish out nicely. Original sights and ramrod. Action works fine.
- R. 8. **Henry Repeating Arms Model H001.** Serial # T51970H. .22 RF caliber lever action rifle with a 20" octagon barrel. The bore is excellent. This classic lever gun features a blued steel barrel with a black alloy receiver. The blued metal finish on the barrel and magazine tube is in very good condition showing little wear with a couple of small dings and some light scratching. The black finished alloy receiver is very good as well with some light scuffs and scattered scratches. The plain walnut forearm is in very condition with some minor marks from use. The matching plain walnut butt stock is very good to excellent showing some light scratching. The action works fine.
- R. 9. **Iver Johnson Model Champion.** Serial # 1454D. 12 Ga. single shot shotgun with a 30" barrel. The bore is fair, clean with moderate pitting at the breach end. The barrel is choked Full. The finish on the barrel is fair, it is a blotchy brown/gray patina with cleaned surface rust. The receiver is a dark brown patina with edge wear. The plain walnut stock and forearm are in good condition with dings, scratches and finish wear. Original butt plate is in fair condition with wear, chips and scratches. The action works OK. C&R.
- R. 10. **Hawk Industries - H&R 1871 Model Pardner Pump.** Serial # NZ784444. 20 Ga. pump action shotgun with a 26" ventilated rib barrel. The bore is excellent. The barrel uses screw in choke tubes and comes with an Imp. Mod. choke tube installed. This gun is very similar to a Remington 870 and features matte black finished metal. The finish on the barrel and receiver is in very good condition with some scattered light scuffs and scratches. The oil finished walnut stock and forearm are in good to very good condition with some minor dings and scratches. The action works fine. Includes a combination choke wrench/tool.
- R. 11. **Acme Arms Co. Model Hammer Double.** Serial # 10. 12 Ga. double barreled hammer shotgun with 28" barrels. The bores are poor to fair with heavy pitting in the right barrel, moderate pitting in the left barrel. The barrels are both choked Modified. Made in Belgium. Barrels marked "Belgium Fine Damascus". The metal finish on the barrels shows heavy rust. The engraved receiver shows light rust. The checkered walnut forearm is fair showing wear with numerous dings. The matching butt stock is in fair to good condition with dings and finish wear. Steel butt plate. Action works OK, the right hammer has been repaired and the right firing pin is frozen. The action is tight. C&R.

12. **American Machine Works Model Smith Carbine.** Serial # 8782. .50 caliber black powder percussion rifle with a 21- 5/8" barrel. The bore is good, mostly clean with some light corrosion in the grooves. Marked on the left side breech "ADDRESS POULTNEY & TRIMBLE, U.S.A.". Manufacture's name is illegible but appears to be "MANUFACTURED BY AM'N M'CH'N WKS". The finish on the barrel and barrel latch appears to be an old re-blue which has again rusted. The receiver is a gray patina with some light surface rust on the hammer and trigger guard. There is a screw missing from the breech area with one screw broken off in the receiver; both are for the sling bar, which is missing. The walnut stock and forearm are in good condition with scattered dings and finish wear. Very good inspector's cartouche on the left side wrist. Original carbine rear sight and fixed front sight. Hammer screw replaced. The action does not work, the hammer seems to hit half and full cock notches, but there is no spring tension.
- R. 13. **Marlin Model Glenfield 25.** Serial # 25660675. .22 RF caliber bolt action rifle with a 22" barrel. The bore is excellent. Detachable magazine NOT INCLUDED. The blued metal finish on the barrel is in poor to fair condition with heavy rust. The blued finish on the grooved receiver is fair with scattered light rust. The hardwood stock is in good condition with some dings and scratches. Original front and rear sights with light rust. Sling swivels. The floor plate is rusty and the plastic trigger guard is coated with a white substance. Action works OK.
14. **Thompson Center Model Hawken Flintlock Rifle.** Serial # 15377. .50 caliber flintlock rifle with a 29" octagon barrel. The bore is very good, clean with strong rifling and just a hint of some light rust. Early production rifle made c. 1973. Double set triggers. The blued metal finish on the barrel is in very good condition showing little wear with a hint of light rust around the muzzle, some widely scattered dots of light freckling and some fine scratches. The brass butt plate, trigger guard and patch box are in good condition and should polish up fine. Good case color on lock plate, hammer and frizzen. The plain walnut stock is in good condition with minor marks from use, some older cleaned mildew stains and some light finish wear. The action seems to function OK including the double set triggers. Includes the ramrod.
- R. 15. **Winchester Model 77.** Serial # NSN. .22 RF caliber semi auto rifle with a 22" barrel. The bore is excellent. Detachable box magazine. The blued metal finish on the barrel and receiver is in near excellent condition showing little sign of wear with some minor marks and fine scratches. The plain walnut stock is in excellent condition showing little wear. Original butt plate. Original front and rear sights. Action works fine. C&R.
- R. 16. **Mossberg Model 500C.** Serial # R227120. 20 Ga. pump action youth shotgun with a 22" ventilated rib barrel. The bore is excellent. The barrel accepts screw-in Accu-Choke tubes, an Imp. Mod. tube is installed. The chamber is 3". The blued metal finish on the barrel is in very good condition with some scattered dots of cleaned surface rust. The finish on the alloy receiver is excellent showing little wear. The checkered hardwood stock and forearm are in condition showing no wear. Swivel studs. Factory recoil pad with LoP of 13". Action works fine.
- R. 17. **Winchester Model 1900.** Serial # NSN. .22 RF caliber bolt action single shot rifle with an 18" barrel. The bore is fair, mostly clean with moderate roughness. The Model 1900 was the predecessor to the Model 1902. The metal finish on the barrel and receiver has been aggressively cleaned to a bare gray. The hardwood stock is in fair condition with a repaired crack through the take-down screw. It is loose. Original fixed sights. Made without a butt plate. Action works fine. Made from 1899 until 1902. C&R.
- R. 18. **Mossberg Model 385T.** Serial # 481364. 20 Ga. bolt action shotgun with a 26" barrel. The bore is very good. The barrel is choked Full and the chamber is 3". Detachable magazine. The blued metal finish on the barrel and receiver is in good condition showing little wear with scattered spots of light surface rust. The hardwood stock is in very good condition showing only some minor marks and widely scattered cleaned mildew stains. Bolt mounted safety. Original butt plate. Action works great.

- R. 19. **Ruger Model M77**. Serial #71-97445. .270 Win caliber bolt action rifle with a 22" barrel. The bore is excellent. This is a "Liberty" gun made in 1976 with the inscription "Made in the 200th year of American Liberty" on the barrel. Tang Safety. Made without sights. The blued metal finish on the barrel is in excellent condition showing little wear. The receiver finish is excellent as well. The checkered walnut stock is very good to excellent with some scattered minor marks from use. Original red rubber Ruger recoil pad. Action works fine. Includes a Redfield 2-7x scope in the original Ruger rings.
- R. 20. **Winchester Model 58**. Serial # NSN. .22 RF caliber bolt action manually cocked single shot rifle with an 18" round barrel. The bore is excellent, clean with strong rifling. The finish on the barrel and receiver looks like an old re-blue which has turned mostly brown with some scattered light freckling and light scratches. The hardwood plank style stock is in good condition with a few small dings and scratches. Made without a butt plate. Original sights. Action works fine. Approximately 38,992 made from 1928 to 1931. C&R.
- R. 21. **Winchester Model 72A**. Serial # NSN. .22 RF caliber bolt action rifle with a 25" barrel. The bore is excellent. 2/3 length tubular magazine. The rifle features the desirable chrome bolt, chrome trigger guard and grooved receiver. The blued metal finish on the barrel and grooved receiver is in good to very good condition showing light wear with some scattered spots of light surface rust and light scratches. The plain walnut stock is in good condition showing light marks, scratches and light finish wear. Original sights. Action works fine. Made from 1935 to 1963. C&R.
- R. 22. **Russian – K.B.I. Model SKS-45**. Serial # RH006982. 7.62x39mm caliber semi auto rifle with a 20" barrel. The bore is excellent. Made at the Tula Arsenal in 1954, generally noted to be one of the best of the various manufactured SKS's. All numbers match with no force matching. There is a small arsenal mark on the bolt indicating a re-furbishment at some time in its history. The blued metal finish is very good showing some light edge wear and light scratching. The hardwood stock and forearm are in good to very good condition with some small marks and scuffs with some flaking finish. Blade bayonet. Cleaning kit is missing from the butt trap. Action works fine. C&R.
- R. 23. **Mossberg Model 9200**. Serial # SA5181. 12 Ga. semi auto shotgun with a 28" ventilated rib barrel. The bore is excellent. The barrel features Mossberg Accu-Choke screw in chokes and has an Modified choke installed. 3" chamber. Gas operated and designed to shoot any shell interchangeably. The blued metal finish on the barrel is excellent showing no wear. The black finish on the engraved alloy receiver is excellent as well. The checkered walnut stock and forearm are in very good to excellent condition showing only some minor marks from handling. Brown rubber recoil pad with a LOP of 14". Action works fine. The gun shows little if any use. Includes a box, but not the correct box, a 24" rifle slug barrel, 2 extra choke tubes (Skeet, Full) and a choke wrench. Made from 1996 to 1998.
- R. 24. **Savage Model 444 B**. Serial # 601486. 20 Ga. over and under shotgun with 26" ventilated rib barrels. The bores are excellent. The barrels are both choked Cylinder. The chambers are 3". Made in Italy. Single selective trigger with auto ejectors. The blued metal finish on the barrels is in excellent condition showing little wear. The engraved blued receiver is very good showing edge wear and light carry wear. The checkered walnut stock and forearm are in very good condition showing minor marks and dings from use. LOP is 14". Action works fine.
- R. 25. **Remington Model 660**. Serial # 109884. .308 Win. caliber bolt action rifle with a 20" barrel. The bore is excellent. Dog leg bolt handle. The rifle was made in 1968. The blued metal finish on the barrel is in very good condition showing some light scuffs and fine scratches. The receiver finish is excellent showing little wear. Original sights. The gloss finished checkered walnut stock with black nose piece and pistol grip cap is in very good condition showing only a few minor marks. Original butt plate. The black plastic trigger guard is not warped. Action works fine. Made from 1968 to 1971. Includes a Bushnell Scope Chief IV 4x scope in a Weaver flip mount. C&R.

- R. 26. **Winchester Model 94 SRC Wells Fargo & Co. Commemorative.** Serial # WFC10803. .30-30 Win. caliber lever action rifle with a 20" barrel. The bore is excellent. Made in 1977. These originally came with a silvered receiver and this one is slightly tarnished. The condition of the other metal parts is excellent with no wear. The checkered walnut stock and forearm are in excellent condition with a few small handling marks. The action works fine. There is evidence that the gun was fired, a very light drag line on the loading gate and feed ramp. The bolt face is not pristine. Includes the original Styrofoam box, cardboard sleeve and instructions. Serial range was WFC1 to WFC19999. C&R.
- R. 27. **Remington Model Seven.** Serial # 7859165. .243 Win caliber bolt action rifle with an 18-1/2" barrel. The bore is excellent. The matte black metal finish on the barrel is in very good to excellent condition showing little wear with some light marks from use. The finish on the receiver and floor plate is excellent showing little wear. The black synthetic stock is in very good condition showing some minor scuffs and scratches from use. Original black rubber Remington recoil pad. Made without sights. Action works fine. Includes a Leupold Rifleman 2-7x33 Scope, the original box and the box for the scope.
28. **Armsport Model Kentuckian Flintlock Rifle.** Serial # 24723. .45 caliber black powder flintlock rifle with a 35" octagon barrel. The bore is very good, strong rifling with just a hint of some light rust in the grooves. Made in Italy. Single trigger. The blued metal finish on the barrel is in is in good condition with some dings, scratches and scattered spots of light surface rust. The lock plate, hammer and frizzen show good case color. There is rust on the frizzen spring. The gloss finished full length walnut stock is in very good condition with some minor marks from use. The brass butt plate, trigger guard, side plate, patch box, nose cap and ferrules are slightly tarnished, but should polish out fine. Action works fine. Includes a ramrod.
- R. 29. **Springfield Armory Model 1898 Krag.** Serial # 172902. .30-40 Krag caliber bolt action rifle with a 22" barrel. The bore is very good, strong rifling with some fouling in the grooves; it may clean better. Made in 1899. This rifle has been sporterized. The barrel was shortened and the rear sight removed. A receiver mounted sight was added and the action re-blued and set in a sporter stock. The blued metal finish on the barrel and receiver is in good condition with some light scratches and small patches of older cleaned surface rust. The plain walnut stock in fair to good condition with some minor marks, There is a crack in the wrist. Action works OK, but is stiff. Includes a leather sling. C&R.
- R. 30. **Smith & Wesson Model Safety Hammerless.** Commonly called the "Lemon Squeezer". Serial # 123614. .38 S&W caliber double action revolver with a 3-1/4" barrel. The bore is good, clean with strong riddling and some light to moderate pitting. This is a 4th model made from 1898 until 1907. The original nickel finish is in good to very good condition showing some finish wear, mostly to the right side with light scratching and a small patch of missing nickel on the right side of the frame. The blued trigger guard shows edge wear. The trigger shows remnant case color. The checkered hard rubber grips are in good condition with wear and discoloration on the right panel. The action works fine. Includes an old Brauer Brothers leather holster. C&R.
- R. 31. **Hamilton Model 43.** Serial # NSN. .22 RF caliber bolt action manually cocked single shot rifle with a 16" brass lined barrel. The barrel is wrapped in sheet metal. The bore is good, clean with strong rifling. The gun is cocked by pulling back the bolt handle. The blued finish on the barrel and receiver is in good to very good condition with light edge wear and scratches. The hardwood plank style stock is in good to very good condition with a few small dings and scratches. Made without a butt plate. Original sights. Action works fine. C&R.
- R. 32. **Daisy Mfg. Model Legacy 2213.** Serial # AC0100838. .22 RF caliber semi-auto rifle with a 19" octagon barrel. The bore is excellent. Detachable magazine. The action is cocked with an action bar at the nose of the stock similar to older Winchesters. The action is released with a button forward of the sling swivel stud. The matte black finish on the barrel and receiver is excellent showing no wear. The plain walnut stock and forearm are in excellent condition as well showing no wear. The action works fine. The gun shows no use and is new. Includes the original box. Made from 1988-1991.

- R. 33. **Ruger Model Security Six.** Serial # 151-25982. .357 Magnum caliber double action revolver with a 4" barrel. The bore is very good, strong rifling with some fouling in the grooves, it may clean to excellent. Made in 1975. Adjustable sights. The blued metal finish on the barrel and frame is excellent showing little wear with some fine scratches. The cylinder shows a light drag line. The checkered aftermarket walnut target grips are in excellent condition showing little wear. The action works fine. Includes the original box, instructions and the original grips. Discontinued in 1988.
- R. 34. **Hamilton Model 47.** Serial # NSN. .22 RF caliber bolt action manually cocked single shot rifle with a 16" brass lined barrel. The barrel is wrapped in sheet metal. The bore is good, clean with strong rifling. The gun is cocked by pulling back the cocking knob at the rear of the receiver. The blued finish on the barrel and receiver is in good condition showing light wear with dings, scratches and some older light cleaned surface rust. The hardwood plank style stock is in good condition with some dings and scratches. Made without a butt plate. Original sights. Action works fine. C&R.
35. **F.LLi Pietta Model 1851 Navy Pepperbox.** Serial # 721636. .36 caliber black powder percussion fired pepperbox revolver with a 3" barrel cluster. The bores are excellent. Made in Italy. Essentially an extra long cylinder on an 1851 Navy frame with no conventional barrel assembly. The blued metal finish on the barrel is excellent showing no wear. The case colored frame is excellent as well. The brass trigger guard/grip frame shows some light tarnishing, but will clean up fine. The plain hardwood grips are excellent showing no wear. The action works fine. pepperbox looks to be unfired.
36. **Unknown Maker Model Percussion Derringer.** Serial # 00113656. .36 caliber percussion fired over/under superposed derringer with 3-1/4" barrels. The smooth bores are good, clean with some very light rust. The barrel group is pulled out and can then be rotated 180 deg to fire the second barrel. The metal finish on the barrel and frame is in the white with dings, scratches and some scattered spots of surface rust. The faux Mother of Pearl grips are in fair to good condition with scratches and a crack in the right panel. The action works OK.
- R. 37. **Browning Arms Model Citori Lighting Grade I.** Serial # 01561PP753. 12 Ga. over/under shotgun with 26" ventilated rib barrels. The bores are excellent. 3" Chamber. The barrels use the Invector screw in choke tube system and come with Cylinder and Modified choke tubes installed. Made in Japan in 1988. Single selective trigger with auto ejectors. The blued metal finish on the barrels is in excellent condition showing little to no wear. The finish on the engraved receiver is very good to excellent condition as well showing just a hint of some light edge wear. The gloss finished checkered walnut stock and forearm are in excellent condition showing little sign of use. Original brown rubber recoil pad with an LoP of 13-1/2". The action works fine and is tight. Includes a Browning luggage case, the instructions and extra choke tubes (Mod. And Full).
- R. 38. **Winchester Model 69A Target.** Serial # NSN. .22 RF caliber bolt action rifle with a 25" barrel. The bore is excellent. 5 shot detachable magazine. The blued metal finish on the barrel and the grooved receiver is in very good condition showing little wear, with some scuffs and light scratching. The plain walnut stock is in very good condition with some minor marks and scratches and some light finish wear. The rear target sight is complete. Action works fine. Made from 1935 to 1963. C&R.
- R. 39. **Winchester Model Ranger 120.** Serial # L1754401. 20 Ga. pump action shotgun with a 28" ventilated rib barrel. The bore is excellent. The barrel features the Winchoke screw in choke system, a Full choke is installed. The blued metal finish on the barrel is very good showing some fine scratches. The black finish on the alloy receiver is very good with some very light scratching. The grooved hardwood forearm is in good to very good condition showing some minor marks from use with some light finish wear. The matching butt stock is in good condition with some marks from use, it appears to have been cut and a black rubber recoil pad added with extra finish applied. The LoP is 13-1/4". Action works fine.

- R. 40. **Mossberg Model 500C.** Serial # R285235. 20 Ga. pump action shotgun with a 26" ventilated rib barrel. The bore is excellent. The barrel accepts Accu-Choke screw-in choke tubes; an Imp. Cyl. tube is installed. The chamber is 3". The blued metal finish on the barrel is in very good condition showing little wear with some light surface rust at the muzzle. The black finish on the alloy receiver is very good showing some light scratching. The checkered hardwood forearm and matching butt stock are in excellent condition showing no wear. Factory recoil pad with LoP of 14". The action works fine. Includes a spare 24" ported and rifled slug barrel with rifle sights also with some light rust at the muzzle.
- R. 41. **Ruger Model Mini-14 Ranch.** Serial # 187-97757. .223 Rem. caliber semi auto rifle with an 18-1/2" barrel. The bore is excellent. Made in 1989. Detachable magazine NOT INCLUDED. Integral scope mounts. The matte black metal finish on the barrel and receiver is very good to excellent showing little wear. The hardwood stock is in excellent condition with only a few minor marks from handling. Black plastic hand guard and butt plate are excellent. Action works fine. Includes a Bushnell Sportview 3-9x32 scope mounted in the Ruger scope rings.
- R. 42. **Marlin Model 30AS.** Serial # 16078003. .30-30 Win. caliber lever action rifle with a 20" barrel. The bore is excellent. Full length magazine tube. The blued metal finish on the barrel and magazine tube is in very good condition showing little wear with some light scratches and scattered light freckling. The blued finish on the receiver is in good condition showing thinning, light edge wear and carry wear with some scratching and scattered spots of light freckling. The lever shows some light edge wear. The plain hardwood stock and forearm are in good to very good condition with some light marks and scratches. Original front and rear sights, the rear sight elevator is missing. Sling swivel studs. The action works fine. Includes a Tasco 3-9x40 scope and a hammer extension.
- R. 43. **Marlin Model Glenfield 30A.** Serial # 18044686. .30-30 Win. caliber lever action rifle with a 20" barrel. The bore is excellent. Full length magazine tube.
