- R. 1. **Remington Model 552 “Speedmaster”**. Serial # A1444598. .22 RF semi auto rifle with a 21” barrel. The bore is excellent. Tubular magazine. The blued metal finish on the barrel is very good to excellent with a few minor marks and some scattered light freckling. The black finish on the alloy receiver is very good with some light scuffs and scratching. The plain hardwood forearm and matching butt stock are in very good condition with a few minor marks on the butt stock. The receiver is grooved for a scope. Action works fine.
- R. 2. **Eastern Arms Model Single Shot**. Serial # NSN. .410 Ga. single shot shotgun with a 26” barrel. The bore is excellent, clean with no pitting. The barrel is choked Full. Made by Crescent Firearms and labeled Eastern Arms. The blued metal finish on the barrel shows light wear with scratches and older cleaned light surface rust. It is beginning to turn brown. The receiver shows remnant case color. The plain walnut stock and forearm have been refinished and are in very good condition with some min or marks from use. Original plastic butt plate. Action works fine. C&R.
- R. 3. **Ruger Model 10/22**. Serial # 115-42276. .22 RF caliber semi auto rifle with an 18½” barrel. The bore is excellent. 10 shot detachable rotary magazine. The blued metal finish on the barrel is in very good condition showing little wear with some scattered spots of light surface rust freckling. The black finished alloy receiver shows some light edge wear with some small dings and scratches. The plain walnut stock is in very good to excellent condition showing some minor marks from use. Original sights. Action works fine. Includes a Tasco 3-7x20 scope mounted to the top rail.
- R. 4. **Winchester Model 1901**. Serial #77421. 10-gauge lever action shotgun with a 32” barrel. The bore is very good, clean with no pitting. The barrel is choked Full. Made in 1920. The blued metal finish on the barrel, magazine tube and receiver has been refinished. The barrel shows some scattered light surface rust. The magazine tube shows some underlying pitting with a dent and a light haze of surface rust. The receiver and lever shows some light scratching. The plain walnut forearm and butt stock have been refinished and are in good to very good condition showing some underlying remnant dings. Checkered steel butt plate. The action works OK. C&R.
- R. 5. **Marlin Model 1895 LTD**. Serial # DFC00480. .45-70 caliber lever action rifle with a 24” half round – half octagon barrel. The bore is excellent. Full length tubular magazine. Cross bolt safety. The rear sight is missing. The blued metal finish on the barrel and magazine tube shows little wear with a few small scratches where the rear sight was. The receiver finish shows little wear with some light surface rust on the underside. Aperture sight added to the top of the receiver. The oil finished plain walnut straight grip stock and forearm are very good to excellent with only some minor marks. Original butt plate. The action works fine.

6. **F. Llipietta Model 1860 Army.** Serial # P55890. .44 caliber black powder percussion revolver with an 8" round barrel. The bore is in very good condition, no rust visible. Made in Italy. Fluted cylinder. The blued metal finish on the barrel and cylinder is in very good condition with some very light edge wear and light scratching. The case hardened frame, hammer and loading lever show faded case color. The brass trigger guard is very good. The blued steel back strap shows some light freckling. The off-white faux ivory grips are in good condition with some scratches and light soiling. Action works fine. Includes a leather holster.
- R. 7. **Noble Mfg. Co. Model 70J.** Serial # NSN. .410 Ga. Pump action shotgun with a 26" plain barrel. The bore is very good to excellent. The blued metal finish on the barrel shows some light scratches and some scattered light rust. The black finish on the steel receiver shows some edge wear and scratching. The checkered walnut forearm is in good condition with some minor dings. The matching butt stock is in good condition showing some scratches. Original butt plate. Action works OK. C&R.
- R. 8. **Savage Model 24E-DL.** Serial # NSN. .22 RF Mag caliber/20 Ga. over/under rifle/shotgun combination gun with 24" barrels. The bores are excellent. 20 shotgun barrel is choked Full with a 3" chamber. The blued metal finish on the barrels is in good to very good condition showing light muzzle wear and scratching around the scope rail. It looks like it may have had some varnish on the barrel which has mostly worn off. The silver toned finish on the receiver shows little wear with some light scuffs and scratching with wear on the trigger guard. The checkered walnut stock and forearm are in good to very good condition with some scratching and scuffs from use. Original sights. Non-factory recoil pad added. Action works fine and is tight. C&R.
- R. 9. **Remington Model 572 Fieldmaster.** Serial # A1456512. .22 RF caliber pump action rifle with a 21-1/2" barrel. The bore is excellent. Tubular magazine. The original blued metal finish on the barrel shows little wear with a few scratches. The finish on the black alloy receiver shows little wear with some light scratching. The gloss finished checkered walnut forearm is excellent showing no wear. The matching plain walnut butt stock is very good to excellent with some minor marks from use. Original front and rear sights. Action works fine. Includes a silver toned BSA 3-7x20 scope mounted correctly to the grooved receiver.
- R. 10. **Harrington & Richardson Model 1900.** Serial # 131671. 12 Ga. single shot shotgun with a 30" barrel. The bore is poor with heavy pitting. The barrel is choked Imp. Cyl. The finish on the barrel is in fair to good, it is a blotchy dark brown patina with lighter brown thin patches and with light scratching and underlying light pitting. The receiver shows a similar dark brown patina with lighter edges. The plain hardwood stock and forearm have been refinished and are in good condition with some light marks. Original butt plate is worn, no cracks. Action works OK. C&R.
- R. 11. **Winchester Model 1300 XTR.** Serial # LX097554. 12 Ga. pump action shotgun with a 28" plain barrel. The bore is excellent. The barrel features the Win-choke screw in choke system and comes with a Modified choke installed. 3" chamber. The original blued metal finish on the barrel and magazine tube is very good to excellent showing little wear with some light scratching. The black finish on the alloy receiver is very good to excellent showing only a hint of some light edge wear and some light scratches. The grooved hardwood forearm and matching plain butt stock are in very good to excellent condition with some minor marks from use. Original black rubber Winchester recoil pad with an LoP of 14-3/4". Action works fine.
- R. 12. **Marlin Model 336RC.** Serial # U25725. .35 Rem. caliber lever action rifle with a 20" barrel. The bore is excellent. Made in 1960-61. Full length magazine tube. The blued metal finish on the barrel and magazine tube is very good to excellent showing little wear. The blued finish on the receiver is very good showing very light edge wear with some light scratching. The plain walnut forearm and butt stock are in very good to excellent condition showing some light marks and scratches. Stock bullseye is missing. Original front sight with hood, rear sight has been replaced with a flip down sight. Action works fine. Includes a Norinco 1.5-4.5 scope in a Pachmayr flip mount and sling swivel studs. C&R.

- R. 13. **Remington Model 141.** Serial # 10014. .35 Remington caliber pump action rifle with a 24" barrel. The bore is excellent. Made in 1937. Tubular magazine. The blued metal finish on the barrel is in good condition showing light muzzle wear and light scratches. The magazine tube shows wear from carry and use. The finish on the receiver shows a plum hue with edge wear, carry wear and scratching. The grooved walnut forearm has been modified by checkering the grooves and inlaying a plastic diamond. It has been refinished. The walnut butt stock has also been modified by checkering the wrist, adding a grip cap and a recoil pad and refinishing. It is in good to very good condition with some marks from use. Original sights. Action works fine. Includes sling swivels and a padded nylon web sling. Made from 1935 to 1950. C&R.
14. **Unknown Maker Model Percussion Fowler.** Serial # NSN. Approx. 16 Ga. (0.690" Dia) black powder percussion shotgun with a 37" part round, part octagon barrel. The bore is rusty. The barrel has a Belgian proof. The lock plate is un-marked. The barrel looks like it was painted black and is now worn with moderate surface rust. The lock plate is mostly a brownish gray patina. The checkered walnut half-stock is in fair to good condition with dings, scratches and some stress cracks on the left side. There is a repair forward of the lock plate. Steel trigger guard and butt plate. Action works, but it is sluggish. Includes the ramrod.
15. **W. Richards Model Percussion Double.** Serial # NSN. Approx. 16 Ga. (0.680" Dia) double barrel percussion fired shotgun with 32" barrels. The bores are lightly rusted. The finish on the barrels is a rusty brown patina. The lock plates are a cleaned gray patina with older cleaned surface rust. The plain walnut half-stock is in fair to good condition with wear and marks from use. Steel butt plate and trigger guard. Action seems to work, the left nipple is broken with a screw inserted.
16. **Unknown Maker Model Flintlock Rifle.** Serial # NSN. .45 caliber flintlock rifle with a 36" part round-part octagon barrel. The rifled bore is very good, no rust with strong rifling. Single trigger. The barrel finish is a brown patina with light to moderate surface rust. The initials "HTP" dot stamped onto the top of the barrel. The lock plate is a worn gray patina with light surface rust and has no legible markings. The plain walnut full length stock is in very good condition showing some minor marks and scratches from use. Initials "HTP" in brass tacks on butt. Steel butt plate. Brass trigger guard, decorative side plate and ferrules. Adjustable rear sight. The action works OK. Includes a ramrod.
17. **W. Ketland Model Percussion Fowler.** Serial # NSN. Approx. 20 Ga. (0.620" Dia.) black powder percussion fired shotgun with a 32" round barrel. The bore is rusty. W. Ketland was the eldest son of Thomas Ketland, a prominent gun maker in England from the late 1700's through the mid 1800's. The lock is marked W. Ketland, the barrel is not marked. The finish on the metal is a brownish gray patina with light surface rust. The walnut full length stock is in good condition with some minor dings and finish wear. Brass butt plate, trigger guard and ferrules. Includes the ramrod. The action works and holds on both half and full cock.
18. **George Newton Model Percussion Double.** Serial # NSN. Approx. 12 Ga. (0.730" Dia) double barrel percussion fired shotgun with 32" barrels. The bores are lightly rusted. The lock plates are marked George Newton. George Newton was a Birmingham, England gun maker who operated from 1838 until the early 1920's. The finish on the barrels is a brownish gray patina with light surface rust. The barrel rib is marked "Laminated Steel". The nicely engraved lock plates are a gray patina with older surface rust on the right plate. The nicely figured checkered walnut half-stock is in good condition with wear and marks from use. Steel butt plate and trigger guard. Action seems to work OK. Includes a ramrod.
19. **Keyser Model Percussion Fowler.** Serial # NSN. Approx. 16 Ga. (0.660" Dia) black powder percussion shotgun with a 36" part round, part octagon barrel. The bore is rusty. The barrel is marked Keyser at the breech. The lock plate is marked Keyser. The barrel finish is a brownish gray patina with light surface rust. The engraved lock plate is worn a gray patina with some spots of older cleaned surface rust. The checkered walnut half-stock is in good condition with some dings and scratches. Steel trigger guard and butt plate. Action works OK. Includes the ramrod.

20. **Japanese Model Tanegashima Match Lock rifle.** Serial # NSN. Approx. 50 cal. black powder match lock rifle with a 41" octagon barrel with a belled muzzle. The bore is good, no rust visible. The barrel finish is a rough dark brown patina with light surface rust. The walnut rifle stock is in good to very good condition and is adorned with decorative and intricate brass inlays. There is a fine stress crack along the bottom. Brass lock plate with external lockwork. The action works, but the main spring is weak. Match lock rifle were used in Japan from the middle 1500's until the mid-1800's. The ramrod is missing.
21. **Unknown Maker Model Flintlock Rifle.** Serial # NSN. .45 caliber flintlock rifle with a 41" octagon barrel. The rifled bore is in good condition, light rust with good rifling. The barrel measures 0.955" across the muzzle and about 0.960" at the breech end. Double set triggers. The barrel finish is a brown patina with light to moderate surface rust. The initials "HTP" dot stamped onto the top of the barrel. The lock plate is bare metal with light surface rust. It is marked "Ashmore Warrented" and a 1776 date that looks like a reproduction, not authentic. The plain hardwood full length stock with line carvings and brass embellishments is in very good condition showing some minor marks and scratches from use. Brass butt plate, trigger guard, patch box, side plate and ferrules. The action does not work. Includes a ramrod.
22. **Unknown Maker Model Flintlock Rifle.** Serial # NSN. .45 caliber flintlock rifle with a 42" part round-part octagon barrel. The rifled bore is in good, mostly clean with good rifling. Single trigger. The barrel finish is a dark brown patina with light to moderate older surface rust. The initials "HTP" dot stamped onto the top of the barrel. The lock plate is bare metal with light surface rust. It is marked "Tower" with the Crown and GR that looks like a reproduction, not authentic. The plain hardwood full length stock with line carvings and brass embellishments is in good condition showing some marks, scuffs and scratches from use. Brass butt plate, trigger guard, patch box, side plate and ferrules. The action works OK. Includes a ramrod.
- R. 23. **Marlin Model 39.** Serial # 3496. .22 RF caliber lever action rifle with a 24" octagon barrel. The bore is good, mostly clean with good rifling. There are some dark patches that may clean up. Tubular magazine. This is a very early no-prefix model with the "Corporation" marked barrel (The Marlin Firearms Corporation). Made in in the early 1920's. The blued metal finish on the barrel is covered with a fine light to moderate rust and is turning brown. The receiver finish is a brown patina with no case color showing. The walnut stock and forearm are in very good condition with small dings, scratches and finish wear. Original butt plate. Stock bullseye is intact. Original sights. Action works fine. Made from 1922 to 1938. C&R.
- R. 24. **A.H. Fox Gun Co. Model Grade A Double.** Serial # 28581. 12 Ga. double barrel shotgun with 28" barrels. The bores are excellent, clean and shiny. The barrels are choked Full and Imp. Mod. Made c. 1922-1923. Double triggers and extractors only. The blued metal finish on the barrels is in good condition showing some light scuff marks and light scratching. There are some tiny dings in the left barrel. The "Ansley H. Fox" marked engraved receiver is a dark gray patina with traces of case color and carry wear to the underside. The top tang has some light surface rust. The nicely figured checkered walnut beavertail is in good to very good condition with some minor marks from use and some finish wear. The latch shows faded case color. The matching checkered walnut butt stock is in fair condition with some marks from use and damaged finish. Non-factory recoil pad with an LoP of 13-7/8". Action works fine and is still tight and solid. Please see the pictures to get a better idea of the condition. C&R.
- R. 25. **Savage Model 99G.** Serial # 322901. .300 Savage lever action take-down rifle with a 24" barrel. The bore is excellent. Made in 1929. Internal rotary magazine with cartridge counter. The blued metal finish on the barrel is in good to very good condition with some thinning, light scratching and some widely scattered freckling. The finish on the receiver shows some light edge wear with some scratching and scattered spots of older cleaned surface rust. The lever shows fading case color with some remnant protective lacquer. The checkered walnut forearm is in good condition with some minor marks and finish wear. The matching pistol grip butt stock is in fair condition with significant finish loss with scrapes and scratches. The grip cap is missing. Original grooved steel butt plate. Rear sight and front sight blade are replacements. The action works fine. C&R.

- R. 26. **Parker Bros. Model Trojan.** Serial # 197577. 12 Ga. double barreled shotgun with 28” barrels. The bores are good, mostly clean with some light roughness near the chamber end. The barrels are choked Full and Imp. Mod. Made in 1922. Double triggers and extractor only. The blued metal finish on the barrels is in good condition showing little actual wear with a light to moderate covering of older surface rust freckling. The receiver is a brownish gray patina with edge wear and carry wear. The checkered walnut forearm is in very good condition showing little wear. The matching checkered walnut buttstock is in fair to good condition with some minor marks and scratches. The wood has been cut to an LoP of 13-1/4”. The butt plate/pad is missing. The butt has a reddish epoxy-like substance streaked on it. The action works fine and is tight. C&R.
- R. 27. **Marlin Model 39.** Serial # S6336. .22 RF caliber lever action rifle with a 24” octagon barrel. The bore is excellent, clean with strong rifling. Tubular magazine. This is an early S prefix model with the “Corporation” marked barrel (The Marlin Firearms Corporation) and the star marking on the upper tang. S prefix guns were made from 1926 until 1932. The blued metal finish on the barrel is in fair condition with edge wear and scratching and a fine light to moderate coating of rust and is turning brown. The magazine tube is worn to gray and is turning brown. The receiver finish is a brownish gray patina with traces of case color showing. The walnut stock and forearm are in very good condition with small dings, scratches and finish wear. Original butt plate is broken at the toe. Stock bullseye is intact. Original sights replaced with a Redfield receiver mounted aperture sight and a large bead front sight. Rear dovetail filled with a blank. Action works fine. Made from 1922 to 1938. C&R.
- R. 28. **Winchester Model 52 Target.** Serial # 8117. .22 RF caliber bolt action rifle with a 28” heavy barrel. The bore is excellent. Made in 1927. The blued metal finish on the barrel and receiver shows light wear with some light scratches and older light surface rust freckling. The barrel is fitted with scope blocks. The receiver has been fitted with a Marbles aperture sight. Front hooded sight. The plain walnut finger groove target stock is in good to very good condition showing finish wear and light marks from use. Original steel butt plate. 5 shot detachable magazine. Action works great. Includes a leather sling. C&R.
- R. 29. **Winchester Model 50 Featherweight.** Serial # 163825A. 12 Ga. semi auto shotgun with a 28” ventilated rib barrel. The bore will clean to very good. Lightweight version of the standard Model 50. Made in 1954. The blued finish on the barrel is in good to very good condition with some thinning and fine scratches. The barrel is fitted with a Herter’s adjustable choke. The black finish on the alloy receiver is in good condition with some edge wear and light scratches. The checkered walnut stock and forearm are in very good condition showing some minor marks and scratches. Original butt plate. The action works fine. Made from 1954 to 1961. C&R.
- R. 30. **Marlin Model 1893.** Serial # D4086. .32-40 Win. caliber lever action rifle with a 26” octagon barrel and a full length magazine tube. The bore is very good/excellent, clean with strong rifling. Made c. 1916. The blued metal finish on the barrel and magazine tube is in good condition with edge wear, scratching and older spots of cleaned surface rust. The finish on the receiver is a grayish patina with faded case color and carry wear. The lever shows faded case color. The plain walnut stock and forearm are in good condition with dings, scratches, and finish wear. Crescent steel butt plate is a dark gray patina. Action works fine. Made 1893 to 1935. C&R.
- R. 31. **American Gun Co. Model Knickerbocker.** Serial # 165952. 12 Ga. double barrel shotgun with 23-3/4” barrels. The bores are good, mostly clean with some small patches of light roughness. The barrels are choked Modified and Full. The blued metal finish on the barrels is in fair to good condition showing moderate wear and thinning with scratching and a covering of older light surface rust freckling. The receiver is a brownish gray patina. The checkered walnut forearm is in fair to good condition, it is taped to the barrels. The matching butt stock is in good condition showing finish wear and marks from use. Original butt plate. The action works OK, the barrel to frame fit is a bit loose. C&R.

- R. 32. **Savage Model 1899 .250-3000 Rifle.** Serial # 201119. .250-3000 Savage lever action take-down rifle with a 22" lightweight round barrel. The bore is excellent, clean with strong rifling. Made in 1918-1919. This rifle was made to introduce the Charles Newton designed .250-3000 cartridge. The blued metal finish on the barrel is in good condition showing little wear with a patch of finish loss due to older cleaned surface rust and some light scratching. The receiver is worn to bare gray. A side scope mount that required drilling has been attached to the left side. The lever is worn to near gray with traces of case color and some spots of surface rust. The checkered walnut forearm is in very good condition with some minor marks and finish wear. It is numbered to the gun. The matching checkered walnut pistol grip stock is in good condition with some minor marks and light finish wear. A non-factory recoil pad has been added. Rear sight has been replaced with a King adjustable sight. Original front sight. Action works fine. C&R.
- R. 33. **Lefever Arms Co. Model I Grade Double.** Serial # 49370. 12 Ga. double barreled shotgun with 30" barrels. The bores are very good, clean with no pitting. The barrels are choked Full and Imp. Cyl. Made in 1903. Double triggers and extractors. The blued metal finish on the barrels is in fair condition with wear, thinning, scratching, moderate older surface rust freckling and paint spatter. The receiver is a brownish gray patina. The checkered walnut butt stock and matching forearm are in fair to good condition with marks from use, finish wear and paint spatter. Original butt plate is cracked. Action does not work properly. C&R.
34. **Remington Model Rolling Block Military Rifle.** Serial # 1840. .43 Spanish caliber single shot falling block rifle with a 35" barrel. The bore is fair with mostly good rifling with some scattered light pitting and rust in the muzzle end of the barrel. The metal finish on the barrel is a heavily rusted and pitted brown/black patina. The receiver is a brown patina. The plain walnut forearm has been cut down and the barrel hardware (bands and cleaning rod) discarded. The plain walnut butt stock is in fair condition. It was cut and has a crack through the wrist. It looks like it was painted brown. Large No. 1 action seems to work okay.
- R. 35. **Harrington & Richardson Model 1900.** Serial # A56967. 12 Ga. single shot shotgun with a 30" barrel. The bore is fair, dirty with light pitting. The barrel is choked Imp. Mod. The finish on the barrel is in fair condition, a rusty brown patina with scuffs, scratching and paint streaks. Front bead is missing. The receiver is a brown patina with edge wear. The plain walnut stock and forearm are in fair to good condition with light marks, paint streaks and finish wear. Original butt plate is worn, no cracks. Action works OK. C&R.
- R. 36. **Iver Johnson Model Champion Side Snap.** Serial # 10235. 12 Ga. single shot shotgun with a 32" barrel. The bore is poor, dirty and pitted. The barrel is choked Full. The metal finish on the barrel is a brown patina with light to moderate rust freckling. The nickel plating on the frame is mostly gone with the metal being a brown patina. The trigger guard/opening lever has been weld repaired. The plain walnut stock and forearm are in fair condition with some small dings, scratches and finish wear with cracks at the upper and lower tang. The butt plate looks original, and looks like it had foam padding glued to it at one time. The action works OK. Made c. 1890's to early 1900's. C&R.
- R. 37. **Winchester Model 60A.** Serial # NSN. .22 RF caliber bolt action single shot rifle with a 23" barrel. The bore is excellent. The metal finish on the barrel and receiver is a brown patina with light to moderate surface rust freckling. The plain walnut stock is in good condition with dings, scratches, and wear. Original front and rear sights. Original butt plate. Action works OK. C&R.
- R. 38a. **First of a lot of 2: Hamilton Model 27.** Serial #NSN. .22RF tip up boy's rifle with a 15" tip-up barrel (15" barrel has been exempted from NFA). The bore is fair, worn and dirty with some light pitting and visible rifling. The metal finish on the barrel and receiver is a poor/fair gray patina that is heavily pitted. The plain hardwood forearm has been altered in shape, no cracks. The butt stock has been refinished and is in good condition with some scratches and patches of discoloration. The stock is loose. Steel butt plate is heavily pitted. The action works OK. Should not be fired with modern ammunition. C&R.

- R. 38b. **Second of a lot of 2: Hamilton Model 27.** Serial #NSN. .22RF tip up boy's rifle with a 15" tip-up barrel (15" barrel has been exempted from NFA). The bore is fair, worn and dirty with some light pitting and visible rifling. The metal finish on the barrel and receiver is a gray patina with some pitting. The plain hardwood forearm and butt stock are in fair to good condition with dings, scratches and finish wear. The forearm is cracked. The steel butt plate is rusted and pitted. The action works OK. Should not be fired with modern ammunition. C&R.
39. **CVA Model Stag Horn Magnum.** Serial # 61-13-041036-02. .50 caliber black powder muzzle loading rifle with a 24" round barrel. The bore is excellent, clean with strong rifling. The blued metal finish on the barrel and receiver is in excellent condition showing little wear. The checkered black synthetic pistol grip butt stock is in excellent condition showing little to no wear. Front and rear fiber optic sights. Uses a #209 shotgun primer for ignition. Action works fine. Includes the ramrod.
- R. 40. **J. Stevens Arms Model 17 Favorite.** Serial # I50. .32 RF caliber single shot boy's rifle with a 22" part octagon, part round barrel. The bore is poor, rusted and pitted. The metal finish on the barrel is a dark brown patina with moderate surface rust. The receiver and lever are a brown patina as well. The walnut stock and forearm are in good condition with some dings from use with some finish wear, no cracks. Original fixed sights. Action works fine. C&R.
- R. 41. **Remington Model 721.** Serial # 58111. .30-06 caliber bolt action rifle with a 24" barrel. The bore is excellent. Made in 1949. The blued metal finish on the barrel and receiver is in very good condition showing little wear. The front sight is missing and the finish disturbed, the base was ground off and the metal refinished. The rear sight is missing also. The trigger guard and floor plate show edge wear and thinning. The plain walnut stock is in very good condition with some minor marks from use, there is a slight chip missing at the toe.
