

John Gideon Laidacker



Born 25 December 1867 in Exchange, Montour County, PA to Daniel Laidacker (1844-1929) and Christiana Wertman (1836-1890), John Gideon Laidacker was a collector almost from birth. In a 1926 article (Berwick Enterprise, 17 Dec. 1926, p. 19), he stated that he began when he was six or seven with a “two copper pennies, the first bearing the date of the birth of his mother and the second that of his father.” He noted in his typewritten autobiography that, at a young age, he “did not have the cold cash but some times could trade my labor on what I desired.” When John’s father tried to stop John from accumulating rifles and grandfather’s clocks, John ran away at age 14 (Monthly Bugle, March 1993, p. 2). Although some biographers have concluded that John was educated at home, E. H. Painter, “Member of the Northumberland County Bar and former teacher of Public School,” stated, in a letter of recommendation in 1888, that “J. G. Laidacker of Turbotville, is a young man of excellent business...well educated in our public schools.” By 1891 he was “under instruction” as a telegraph operator for the Pennsylvania Railroad (PRR). This training for the railroad prepared him for his service in the U. S. Signal Corps. On 1 Sept 1893 John was appointed PRR agent at New Boston, PA and later transferred to St. Clair, PA. On 2 June 1898 he married Katie Mae Deibler (1875-1957) of Berrysburg, Dauphin Co., PA. They had six children including John Daniel (1899-1990), Robert J. (1900-1903), Samuel H. (1904-1994), Richard H. (1907-1908), Edith May (1909-2002), and Katherine Margaret (1916-2009). Finally, in 1908, John was transferred to Mocanaqua, PA as station agent and the family moved to Shickshinny, PA. There he established his Old Curiosity Shop at 24 North Main Street. John’s serious interest in coins was evident as early as 29 October 1894 when, according to an article in the Miner’s Journal of Pottsville, PA, his collection of U.S. copper cents from 1793 to 1894 was on exhibition in R. H. Bergman & Co’s show windows. In the article announcing the exhibit, John noted that he was looking for a 1793 and 1804 copper cent. (Copy of article at end of this biography) On 3 Nov 1894, a follow-up article noted that he had secured both coins and that “this completed his collection with the exception of the 1799 cent which is very rare and highly valued.” John soon began issuing a “Sixteen page Price List of U.S. Coins Seldom found in Circulation.” (Copy of cover at end of biography) His 1901 account book shows him buying “100 dimes 1831-1856” for \$11.00 and “17 dimes and quarter dollars” for \$3.26. By 1910, John was selling antiques including coins and firearms to major collectors. His job as station agent for the PRR gave him a free pass wherever the PRR went and he took advantage of that to travel throughout the eastern U.S. He could also use the telegraph in the evening to ask other station agents to collect items and send them to him using his PRR employee free shipping privilege. A 17 December 1926 newspaper article in the Berwick Enterprise (page 19), headlined “Henry Ford Comes to Shickshinny Man for His Relics of Bygone Days” noted that “many of the famous collectors of America, among them Frank Sibley of Boston and H. B. Harner of Philadelphia are in constant communication with him.” John noted in that article that “his collection of coins is one of the most interesting to be found in America and is complete with the exception of a few rare coins for which he is constantly on the lookout.” When he died suddenly on 9 June 1927 of a ruptured appendix, his hastily written will left his entire estate to his wife Katie and, “after her death to be

divided equally between the children.” And what an estate, it was. According to John’s obituary [Mountain Echo newspaper], he had “a museum of antiques” housed in the “former Odd Fellows building, with a number of smaller buildings on his residence lot as well as a barn on Vine Street [Shickshinny]....His collection of coins had everything from the widow’s mite [sic] and pine tree shilling to coins of later date. Men of National reputation as collectors Henry Ford, Thomas A. Edison and others have visited Mr. Laidacker’s Old Curiosity Shop in Shickshinny.” To raise money, the family sold some antiques at auction in 1930 by L. J. Gilbert. The sale included “7 desks, 30 chests of drawers, 40 tables, 500 pieces of Glass and China, 100 Chairs, 6 Settees, 25 Clocks, 10 corner Cupboards, and several hundred other antique pieces.” While no coins or guns were sold at this auction, John’s grandson John Samuel Laidacker (AKA Jack) remembers that the family had to sell some muskets in the early 1950’s “as they were making the barn lean.” Other than those sales, the coins, firearms, and the rest of the estate remained intact for 30 years. When Katie Deibler Laidacker died in 1957, the four surviving children sold a portion of the coin collection at Jake Borry’s Auction House in Ephrata on 20 June 1959. They then divided the rest of the antiques in the estate including a large number of coins into four equal shares. The coins being sold at Horst Auction House in Ephrata, PA represent one of those four shares and are offered by one of J. G. Laidacker’s granddaughters. J. G. Laidacker’s legacy as an antique dealer continued on through his descendants with three of his children (John Daniel, Samuel, and Edith) becoming dealers as well as three of his grandchildren and two of his great grandchildren.
